- Back Alley abortions

- Human costs were ignored -

• Lawrence Lader - Abortion I + II (1950s writer)

• Sherri Finkbine -thalidomide

- safe abortion had to be when mom's life was in danger

- Romper Room - She was replaced - people threatened to cut the arms + legs off her 4 kids

• Women used anything to self-abort.

- Patricia Maginnis - early advocate of Women's rights

1970 - NY Planned Parenthood - day after the bill was passed
